Decorate Safely

Decorating is one of the best ways to get in the holiday spirit.

Here are a few tips to help you decorate safely.

- If using an artificial tree, check that it is labeled "fire resistant"
- If you are using a live tree, cut off about 2 inches of the trunk to expose fresh wood for better water absorption, remember to water it, and remove it from your home when it is dry.
- Place your tree at least 3 feet away from any heat sources.
 - Avoid placing breakable ornaments or ones with small, detachable parts on lower tree branches where small children can reach them.
 - Replace light sets that have broken or cracked sockets, frayed or bare wires or loose connections.
- Follow the package directions on the number of light sets that can be plugged into one socket.
- Turn off all lights and decorations when you go to bed or leave the house.


