#### Keeping Safe in a Storm

When a storm is headed you way, make sure that you are prepared. As the bad weather approaches, stay informed about what the next three days will bring. Prepare for flooding my by moving your valuables to higher location. Always keep the fuel tank of your vehicle full.

#### During the storm—

Do not touch any downed power lines or broken glass lines and report them to the police or fire department.

If evacuating, disconnect all electrical appliances.

Stay informed of the weather conditions.

Do not attempt to cross swift-moving water that is above your knees.

If your vehicle stall in the water, abandon it immediately. Two feet of water is enough to carry away most automobiles.

Prepare an evacuation kit that includes personal hygiene items, clothes, bedding and medication.

Dial 911 only if you have a life-threatening emergency.

#### After the Storm—

If you turned off your gas appliances, contact a licensed professional to relight them. If there is no electricity, use flashlights, do not use matches or candles. Avoid making unnecessary trips. If you must go, tell others where you are going.
