**National Water Safety Month**

National Water Safety Month in May prepares us for recreational activities.

Water is an attraction during the summer months. Whether we're drawn to lakes and rivers or public pools and water slides, safety is a necessary concern. We use the water for leisure, sport, and general outdoor relaxation. Boating, swimming, fishing, and many other kinds of recreation take place in and around the water.

**Here are some safety tips:**

- **Always supervise children in and around the water**
- **Never swim alone**—Swimming is safer and more fun with a buddy!
- **Don't dive or jump into water that you can't see through**—Obstacles like rocks and stumps may be hiding under the surface
- **Never turn your back to the ocean**—Big surf and riptides can come without warning
- **Don't depend on floating toys to keep you safe**
- **Children and non-swimmers should always wear life jackets in open water**
- **Swim only in designated swim areas**—Signs are posted for a reason, there may be hidden dangers in non-designated areas.
